You are receiving this letter as a part participant of the Peoria St. Patrick's Day parade. Thank you for your interest in participating in the 39th Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade sponsored by the St. Patrick Society of Peoria. Our primary objective in hosting the St. Patrick's Day Parade is to celebrate our Irish heritage and to promote a safe, family-oriented, fun event.

Since you have opted to use our online registration option in the past, we invite you to do so again. We have a new and improved website which we think you'll really enjoy.

On our application page, you will find all the information you need to register your group for the parade. If you prefer to use traditional mail, you will also find a downloadable PDF containing all the required forms.

Whether you use electronic or traditional registration, all entries are to be postmarked or submitted to the St. Patrick Society by March 7, 2019.

Once your application has been processed, whether mailed or online, you will receive an email which will confirm your application and provide further instructions. Your email address will not be provided to any other entity. The recipient of the Parade Block Position email letter should inform all persons involved with the Parade Entry of your Parade Block Position when announced.

Parade Information: The Parade will start at **2:00 PM** on Sunday, March 17, 2019 at the Corners of Hancock and Monroe Streets.

Assembly Area: The assembly area for the Parade participants are as follows: (A) Blocks 1-2 assigned to the 500 Block of Hancock Street, (B) Blocks 3-4 assigned to the 400 Block of Hancock Street, (C) Blocks 5-6 assigned to the 500 Block of Madison Street, (D) Blocks 7-8 assigned to the 600 Block of Madison Street, (E) Blocks 9-10 assigned to the 500 Block of Green Street, and (F) Blocks 11-12 assigned to the 400 Block of Green Street.

Parade Route: The 2019 Parade Route is as follows: Monroe Street to Main Street, Main Street to Water Street, Water Street to cross the intersection of Hamilton Blvd & Water Street where the parade route ends. Parade vehicles will be directed to proceed Water Street or turn left on Hamilton to exit the parade area.

On behalf of The Parade Committee, we look forward to working with you as we prepare for the 39th Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade. Due to the later start time of this year's event, the St. Patrick Society of Peoria will not be hosting a party following the parade.
