If you would prefer to complete your registration online, you may do so at www.stpatpeoria.com.

Whether you use electronic or traditional registration, all entries are to be postmarked or submitted to the St. Patrick Society by March 7, 2020. When mailing in the paper forms, be sure to include the Parade Application, Liability & Publicity Waiver, and entry fee (if applicable.) Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the parade committee and will be assessed a \$50 late registration fee.

Please review the rules and regulations and forward them to all members of your group. There is new information for 2020.

Once your application has been processed, whether mailed or online, you will receive an email which will confirm your application and provide further instructions. Your email address will not be provided to any other entity. The recipient of all parade related emails should communicate relevant information to all persons involved with your entry group when announced.

Parade Information: The Parade will start at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at the Corners of Hancock and Monroe Streets.

Assembly Area: The assembly area for the Parade participants are as follows: (A) Blocks 1-2 assigned to the 500 Block of

Hancock Street, (B) Blocks 3-4 assigned to the 400 Block of Hancock Street, (C) Blocks 5-6 assigned to the 500 Block of Madison Street, (D) Blocks 7-8 assigned to the 600 Block of Madison Street, (E) Blocks 9-10 assigned to

the 500 Block of Green Street, and (F) Blocks 11-12 assigned to the 400 Block of Green Street.

Any special requests (such as pairing two entries together) should be submitted on the application for consideration. Please understand that staging locations may change year to year or even at the last minute

for logistical or safety reasons.

Parade Route: The 2020 Parade Route is as follows: Monroe Street to Main Street, Main Street to Adams Street, and ending

on Adams Street just before Hamilton Boulevard. At this point, parade vehicles will be directed to continue down Adams Street and exit the Parade area, or return to the staging area via Bryan Street to unload

passengers. Parade vehicles will not be allowed to stop on Adams Street.

Parade Theme: This year marks our 40th Parade since our first in 1980. We encourage all participants to incorporate one or both

of the following themes into their entry: 1) The Number 40, or 2) The Year 1980. The use of one or both of

these concepts will be taken into consideration by the judges. Have fun and be creative!

Our primary objective in hosting the Parade is to celebrate our Irish heritage and to promote a safe, family-oriented, fun event. On behalf of The Parade Committee, we look forward to working with you as we prepare for the 40th Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade. Rules & Regulations for the 40th Annual St. Patrick's Day Parade

The Parade is March 17, 2020, Rain or Shine, and steps off at 11:00 AM from the corner of Monroe Street & Hancock Street. This family friendly parade celebrates and honors our Irish history, culture and traditions.

Deadline for Parade Entries is March 7, 2020. Date of entry will be taken into consideration when assigning line-up positions. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the parade committee and will be assessed a \$50 late registration fee.

All Parade Entries must be pre-registered with the Parade Chair. Parade officials or police officials may remove a unit from the parade during the assembly or any time during the parade if the entry is not adhering to the rules and regulations of the parade.

Entries must be decorated to support the celebrating of St. Patrick's Day. The 2020 parade marks our 40th parade on the streets of Peoria. Participants are encouraged to incorporate the annual theme, the holiday itself, or elements of Irish history, culture, or traditions in their decoration.

The City of Peoria and Peoria Police Department have requested the emphasis of these rules in the interest of crowd control and the safety of the young children attending the parade:

- Candy and beads are **not to be thrown from the moving units.**
- Candy and beads may be handed to the crowd by participants walking a minimum of five feet away from the moving vehicles.
- Candy and beads are not to be distributed until the vehicle leaves the staging area, passing the sign posted "Parade Begins Here."

Shredded Paper (confetti) or Toilet Paper Rolls are not to be projected from any of the walkers, floats, or vehicles.

Entries must keep their unit moving along the parade route with no more than 15 feet between their unit and the unit in front of them. Walkers are expected to keep up with the pace of the vehicles.

No participants are to board or exit parade vehicles once the parade begins its forward motion.

Block Captains will be stationed on each block in the staging area to provide assistance and will escort the parade through the streets. They are authorized to make decisions on behalf of the parade committee and can answer any questions you may have on parade day.

Antique Cars, Custom Vehicles, or Motorcycles may enter individually or as part of a group. Each Antique Car, Custom Vehicle or Motor Cycle must pay the \$30 Entry Fee. There are no group rates.

All walking groups must have an identifying banner which is neatly lettered and legible.

Business units may enter the parade if vehicles are decorated in a way that promotes the business and honors our Irish History, Irish Culture, or Irish Traditions which we celebrate on St. Patrick's Day.

Please check the staging area map ahead of time and enter your block directly from outside the staging area. With safety and limited space in mind, doing so will reduce travel through the staging blocks and eliminate the need to turn vehicles around.

Drivers of all vehicles in the parade must possess a valid driver's license, be at least 18 years old, and possess all liability vehicle insurance. Vehicles must be operated in a safe and responsible manner in accordance with the Illinois Rules of the Road.

Area Politicians may enter the parade as a separate unit or may ride on a float designated for their party. Area politicians include State Senators, State Representatives, Judges, Regional or County Officers, and Local Officers or candidates for any of the aforementioned.

Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any entry, in any vehicle, or on any person in the parade assembly area or during the parade route. Participants consuming alcohol in the assembly area will be removed from the parade. All city, county, and state statutes concerning the consumption of alcoholic beverages will be strictly enforced by the police prior to the start of the parade, during the parade, and after the parade.

The Parade Chair reserves the right to accept or decline any parade entry application. **The Parade Chair's decision regarding all entries is final.**

Parade Officials reserve the right to restrict, limit, or reject any entry that does not abide by the stated parade rules and regulations.

First, Second, and Third Place Awards will be given in the following categories: Business Entries, Family Entries, and Organization Entries.




Parade Liability & Publicity Waiver St. Patrick's Day Parade, March 17, 2020
